



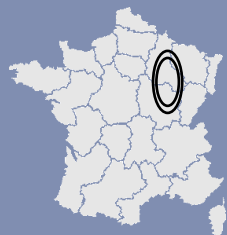
CHAMPAGNE

Very closed to Epernay, Cumières is in the heart of the country of Champagne and the Vallée de la Marne. It is in this typical Champenois village that for over two centuries, **Champagne Philippe MARTIN** develops its wines in the utmost respect of a tradition passed down from father to son on 9 generations. Philippe MARTIN vineyard, located mainly on hillsides facing south, covers 10 hectares within 5 villages. The 3 grapes varieties: *Chardonnay*, *Pinot Meunier* & *Pinot Noir*, are subtly assembled to provide Cuvees and Reserves Champagnes of an exceptional quality and expression.
